Since Karen, as a tenured teacher, is assured a position in the French public school system, she was able to focus attention on family and friends. Please do pray, however, that God would guide those responsible for her school placement.

I worked...hard and it felt sooo good to be back. In the above photo I'm with the president of our regional church association. Philip is also our national church planting director and the lead pastor of the Lagny Church. More importantly, he's my friend. WorldVenture has agreed to loan me to our French church association. It's my turn to be «détaché.» Philip and I have been busy defining my future ministry role... Actually, it's three complimentary roles.

First, the Lagny Church's elder board has recommended to the congregation that I become their part-time Missions Pastor. Members will vote on this decision at the annual «Assemblée Générale» in March. I'd be responsible for this local church's global outreach initiatives

Next, we incorporated Mission OIKOS as a French non-profit organization. I'll be heading up this nascent mission agency with a dynamic international team. As well as continuing to develop intercultural leaders, OIKOS will be sending both short-term and long-term missionaries from our French churches to serve the broader French-speaking world, especially Africa.

Finally, we're exploring an interesting role with the Association Baptiste. This will take time to develop, but initially I will sit as an observer on our French denomination's missions board along with one of my personal heroes, Paul Sanders. We will be
